Our eleven day stay in Kenya begins at the **Hilton Hotel** in Nairobi. After hand-feeding giraffes and visiting with orphaned baby elephants and rhinos we take a leisurely visit to “Out of Africa” author Karen Blixen’s home on the outskirts of Nairobi.

We head north over the equator to our first night in the wild at **Sweet Water Luxury Tented Camp**; everyday while on tour we will have one or two safaris to search for the local game. After Sweet Waters we continue further north to Samburu where we will spend two nights at the wonderful **Samburu Lodge**; this area is well known for its leopards and the gerenuk. Lake Nakuru, our next destination, is world famous for the hundreds of thousands of flamingoes who come here to feed. We will stay one night at the **Sarova Lion Hill Lodge** at Lake Nakuru to see this amazing phenomenon.

As we pass through the Great Rift Valley and the Mau Escarpment we arrive for two nights in the awesome Masai Mara; our lodge is the **Keekorok Lodge**. While in the Mara we will take time to visit an actual Masai Village. Our final lodging is at the foot of Africa’s largest mountain – Mount Kilimanjaro; we spend two nights at the **Serena Amboseli Lodge**. We have our final meal in Nairobi before our departure from this dreamland back home.

Some of the wild animals that you might see are – lions, leopards, cheetahs, elephants, cape buffalos, zebras, giraffes, gerenuks, dik diks, impalas, hippos, rhinos, hyrax, genet, caracal, civet, mongoose, hyena, jackal, warthog, Grant gazelles, Thompson gazelles, bushbucks, waterbuck, kudu, topi, wildebeest, hartebeest, oryx, eland, baboons, monkeys, and hundreds of different variety of birds.
